

Terms and Conditions: Allocation of Tickets for UXCON Vienna

The Vienna Business Agency (Wirtschaftsagentur Wien) is awarding tickets for participation in UXCON Vienna, taking place on 16 and 17 September 2026 in Vienna, to interested Vienna-based entrepreneurs, start-up founders and prospective founders who wish to network at the event. Conference tickets with a value of EUR 750 each will be provided in the form of a coupon code. Selected applicants may redeem the code themselves on the event website at: <https://www.uxcon.io/#pricing>

Who Can Participate?

This offer is aimed at entrepreneurs and individuals with the intention of founding a business in Vienna.

Eligible applicants are:

- Any natural person of legal age residing in Vienna who intends to establish a business in Vienna.
- Any legal entity with its registered office or business location in Vienna.

Applications that do not meet these terms and conditions cannot be considered and will therefore be excluded from participation.

Application Details

Applications may be submitted by email to creativeindustries@wirtschaftsagentur.at until 13 September 2026.

Information regarding the applicant's motivation, the participant, and the existing or planned business is required for participation.

In return, selected participants agree to:

- Attend the event.
- Consent to the taking of photographs during the event and to the use of these photographs by the Vienna Business Agency for promotional purposes.

Only applications that are submitted on time and completed in full will be considered.

Selection Process

Participants will be selected from the valid applications based on the following criteria:

- Motivation for participation as demonstrated in the letter of motivation.
- Particular consideration will be given to the diversity of participants.

Applicants will be informed about the allocation of tickets by Monday, 14 September 2026. The allocation of tickets constitutes State aid within the meaning of Articles 107 and 108 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union (TFEU). This aid is granted under Commission Regulation (EU) No. 2023/2831 of 13 December 2023 on the application of Articles 107 and 108 TFEU to de minimis aid.

The aid qualifies as de minimis aid and does not exceed the maximum amount specified in the Regulation. Recipients of the tickets are required, prior to receiving the tickets, to complete a de

minimis declaration confirming that the benefit received constitutes de minimis aid within the meaning of Articles 107 and 108 TFEU.

This declaration serves to clarify whether, and to what extent, the granting of additional de minimis aid is permissible under EU regulations. The total amount of de minimis aid granted to a single undertaking must not exceed EUR 300,000 over any period of three fiscal years.

Data Protection

The Vienna Business Agency processes the personal data provided by applicants (name, company/company registration number, address, telephone number, email address, URL) on the basis of their consent and for the fulfilment of a legal obligation. The processing of this data is also permitted after the completion of the selection process if it is necessary to safeguard the legitimate interests of the Vienna Business Agency or to comply with a legal obligation.
